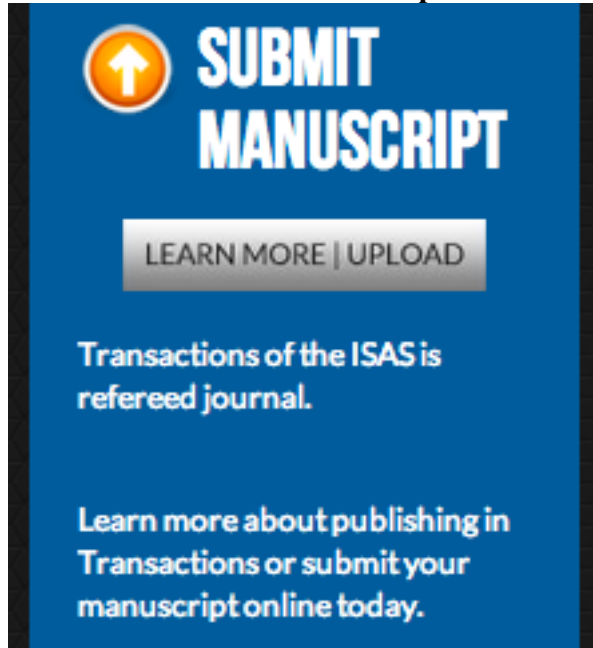


# Submit Manuscript

1. Click on Submit Manuscript button on the home page.

## TRANSACTIONS

*Transactions*, the referred scientific journal of the Illinois State Academy of Science, has been published continually since its inaugural 1908 issue. In an effort to make the author's works available, issues since direct print preparation are available in direct PDF format and issues prior to that time are available as scanned images converted to PDF format. The current and latest prior volume is embargoed from public access, being available only to the membership.

Please take advantage of our searchable (author, title, year) database to view articles published within the Transactions pages. Book Reviews published in *Transactions* are also available. In addition, we will be adding abstracts for posters and presentations from our annual meetings, both without any embargo period.

We will be adding all articles back to our inaugural year as quickly as possible. Status: **2013-1970 manuscripts are currently available**. Older manuscripts are available on the [old ISAS website](#) during the transition process.

On 02/12/2013 the ISAS online manuscript submission portal received your manuscript: Test Manuscript.

Your manuscript will be submitted to 3 reviewers qualified in the area of Agriculture.

While turn-around time varies, the average is about 6-8 weeks before the Editor receives all of the reviews, considers the comments, and then contacts you with notification of acceptance status.

Assuming your manuscript is tentatively accepted, you will then be asked to respond to the reviewers comments and submit a revised manuscript directly to the Editor. The Editor will review your revisions, and if reviewer concerns have been adequately addressed, before formatting your manuscript for publication. Prior to publication you will have the opportunity to receive a pre-press copy, note necessary correction, etc.

One final publication formatting has been completed, you will receive a billing statement for the page charges (\$50/page for members, \$100/page for non-members). Upon receipt of payment, your manuscript will be published online on the ISAS website and you will receive a PDF copy for your own use and distribution.

The move to online publishing eliminates the need to wait for aggregation for print publishing; enhances the process of submission, review, and publication in a cost-effective manner; and presents original work in a more expeditious manner that is fully searchable to encourage dissemination of author's works.
